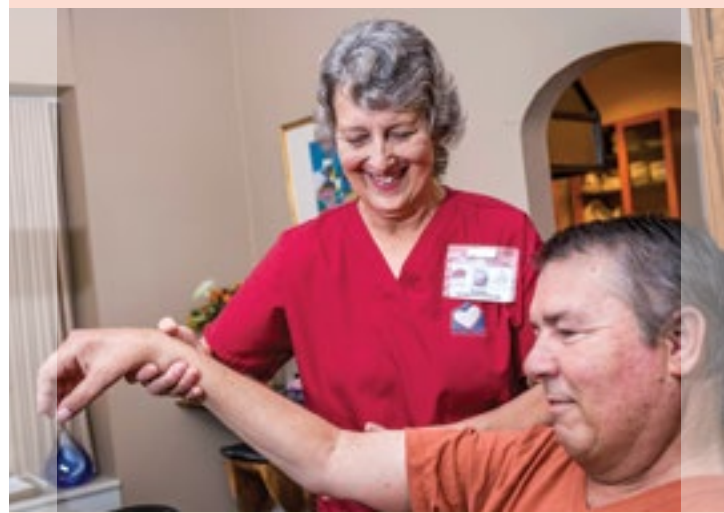

Our staff is available to provide quality care on a short-term or long-term basis.

What Is Help at Home?

Help at Home is non-medical care provided in the home by trained caregivers specializing in personal care assistance, companion care and homemaker services, including the following:

- Light housekeeping and laundry
- Meal planning and preparation
- Shopping and errands
- Scheduling appointments
- Transportation to appointments
- Companionship and caregiver respite
- Bathing, shaving and grooming
- Eating assistance
- Medication set-up and reminder
- Overnight care
- Dementia care



CareLink™

CareLink is an electronic relay device that improves safety in the home by signaling for help in an emergency.

Who Pays for Help at Home?

A free initial visit is offered to customize a care plan after which the clients pay for personalized services. Help at Home care is not covered by Medicare or Medicaid. Long-term care insurance policies and Veterans Administration Benefits may cover some or all of the costs. Check with your long-term care insurance provider to verify coverage.
